Chichester Community Development Trust (CCDT) has spent the last 5 years working on raising funds; securing planning permission; developing drawings and plans to transform The Chapel into a new community space in the heart of the development at Graylingwell Park. We have conserved and enhanced this unique listed building through restoration and reconfiguring the space to be flexible and welcoming.

The Chapel will open its doors in February 2022, available to everybody from Monday to Saturday, 8am-5pm, with a café; a space to meet; a space to share and come together with friends and family; and a pre-school play area for young children to enjoy. Evening events and performances will begin from 6.30pm. The Chapel will occasionally be open on Sundays and Bank Holidays for specific performances and events.

# CHRIS SMITHER + SUPPORT FROM ZAK TROJANO

Born in Miami, during World War II, Chris Smither grew up in New Orleans where he first started playing music as a child. The son of a Tulane University professor, he was taught the rudiments of instrumentation by his uncle on his mother's ukulele. In early 1997 Smither released *Small Revelations*. It climbed the Americana and Triple A radio charts and led to concert dates with B.B. King, Bonnie Raitt, Nanci Griffith, and the hugely successful, original *Monsters of Folk'* tour with Ramblin' Jack Elliott, Dave Alvin and Tom Russell. *Small Revelations* also generated several film projects for Smither. Emmylou Harris recorded his song, "Slow Surprise," for the *The Horse Whisperer* soundtrack on MCA. Doors open at 6.30pm.

Andy Cutting is a rarity. A musician's musician: a soulful and technically outstanding melodeon practitioner with an ear for a fine tune. Many of his tunes have been purloined along the way: some considered contemporary classics on the folk scene. But then, Andy is also a warm and emotive performer, modestly engaging his audiences with his self-deprecating wit and then flooring them with downright staggering musicianship. There are few melodeon players who put so much feeling into their playing, whether it be a set of dance tunes, or accompaniment to a slow English ballad. Doors open at 6.30pm.
